

## **Licence agreement**

Please read the following licence agreement carefully before the installation of the product. By installing the product you agree automatically with the conditions stipulated in the licence agreement.

### **I. Subject matter of the licence agreement**

The publishers E. Grünbeck grants to the end-user a non-exclusive and non transferable licence for use of the software concerning the "Schlüssel zum EPÜ" / "Clé pour la CBE" / "Key to the EPC" and comprising a serial number.

### **I. Scope of the licence agreement**

1. The publishers E. Grünbeck retains all the rights, especially these of the copyright. Moreover the software is the Know How of the publishers E. Grünbeck and is therefore to be protected from thirds.
2. The client has the right to install the software only for its personal use and five times at the maximum, for instance on his working place, on his notebook or at home, however it is not allowed to use these installations simultaneously. Reproductions of the software are prohibited.
3. It is only allowed to print extracts of the book for private use.

### **II. Warranty**

The publishers E. Grünbeck draws your attention to the fact that software can never be completely free of defects. The warranty runs to 6 months from the date of purchase of the software in which defective software will be replaced or repaired under the condition the client sends the software back to the publishers E. Grünbeck. The client has only the right for rescission or reduction of the licence fee if replacement is not possible or the deficiency can not be remedied. Every further warranty is excluded.

### **III. Limitation on liability**

Any liability on the part of the publishers E. Grünbeck is excluded with the exception that the damage is caused by intention or by gross negligence. Moreover there may be a liability from the Product Liability Act.

### **IV. Others**

This agreement is subject to German law. Exclusive jurisdiction for all disputes in connection with the licence agreement is Munich.

The possible invalidity of any provision of the licence agreement does not affect any part of the remaining provisions.
